Summary of Changes

The MSc programme uses a variety of assessment methods and this will continue. The examination will remain as an online assessment, but other assessments such as presentations and posters can return to in-person delivery.

Our Public Awareness assessment involves our students delivering scientific activities to others such as in schools. For the last two years, this assessment has had to change to a written assignment due to the pandemic, but we hope that this in-person assessment can return for 2021/22 delivery.

We made a slight change in 2020/21 to the timing of Commercialisation in Green Chemistry, bringing it forward to start in Spring term and end in the middle of Summer term. We will keep this change as it spreads out the workload for students, and allows them more dedicated project time after the taught component.

Although aspects of ISM planning will continue earlier in the course, research projects will not start in full until around Easter.
