Summary of Changes
<p>Offer holders and continuing students:</p> <p>In terms of the structure of the programme, there are some changes to optional modules for 2021-22. The Human Factors in Safety module (HUFS) will return, and will be taught in the Autumn Term. The Security for Safety Module (SESA) will be withdrawn, but the security material will be available to students as one of two optional tracks on the Advanced Topics in Safety (ADTS) module - the other optional track will be on robotics and autonomous systems.</p> <p>For assessment, we'll be continuing to assess students by open assessment, to be completed over around 7 weeks after the taught sessions in York.</p>
