Summary of Changes

Assessment

In 2020/21 we made some changes to assessments, with practical instrumental or vocal lesson-teaching assessed through video-recording rather than in-person. This was a very successful approach, allowing greater reflection on the material, and we will retain this for everyone in 2021/22. Otherwise, assessments will take place as normal, with the submission of folios of work for assessment.

Departmental Ensembles:
