Summary of Changes
<p><u>Year 1</u></p> <p>Due to uncertainties surrounding Covid restrictions, rather than a field trip at the start of the year, we will have a series of interactive activity sessions at our York Experimental Archaeology Research (YEAR) Centre on campus. These proved to be exceptionally popular with students last year.</p> <p><u>Year 2</u></p> <p>As in 2020/21, will again be removing the summative individual presentations from <b>Themes in Prehistory</b> and <b>Themes in Historical Archaeology</b> in favour of formative group presentations. This will enable students to further develop their presentation skills with peer support and means that the essay will count as 100% of the assessment.</p> <p>The content of <b>Communicating Archaeology</b> remains the same but the format of the summative assessment will change. Weekly in-person workshops provide instructions on how to create outputs, which build towards the summative assessment which will require the production of a 3min pre-recorded video to showcase your outputs.</p> <p><u>Year 3</u></p> <p>There will be no changes to the structure of the programme.</p>
