Summary of Changes
<u>Year 1</u> Due to uncertainties surrounding Covid restrictions, rather than a field trip at the start of the year, we will have a series of interactive activity sessions at our York Experimental Archaeology Research (YEAR) Centre on campus. These proved to be exceptionally popular with students last year.
<u>Year 2</u> As in 2020/21, will again be removing the summative individual presentations from Themes in Prehistory and Themes in Historical Archaeology in favour of formative group presentations. This will enable students to further develop their presentation skills with peer support and means that the essay will count as 100% of the assessment. The content of Communicating Archaeology remains the same but the format of the summative assessment will change. Weekly in-person workshops provide instructions on how to create outputs, which build towards the summative assessment which will require the production of a 3min pre-recorded video to showcase your outputs.
<u>Year 3</u> There will be no changes to the structure of the programme.
