Summary of Changes

Teaching.

1. We are planning to teach all programmes in person

We are expecting all undergraduate students to be in York in Autumn 2021. Students who cannot get to campus by Week 6 of Autumn term will be required to take a leave of absence.

Throughout the academic year, we will provide online support to students who are temporarily unable to attend in-person teaching (for example, because of travel restrictions or self-isolation). For those elements of a module that are in person, our intention is to provide as near as possible equivalent online contact for these students. Those elements of a module that are online only will be accessible equally to all students.

<u>Assessment</u>

All essays/coursework/projects and exams will be **online**. Most exams will be **"24 hour open exams"** with the exception of:

• ECO00013C - Microeconomics 1 - assessed by timed online test

All 20 credit modules will be assessed by two assessments, one in Week 1 of the Spring Term and one in the Summer CAP

Students who are self-isolating or unable to travel will be able to undertake an online alternative to in person presentation-based assessments.

We have no plans to change programme structures at Stage 1, or to withdraw or to reschedule any Stage 1 modules.
