Summary of Changes

We'll be continuing to assess students through a combination of coursework, oral presentations, and examinations. All examinations will be in an open, online format in 21/22. Specific assessment plans will be available for each module by the start of the academic year on our Schedule of Assessment and VLE sites.

We plan to deliver modules in the same terms as in the 2020/1 academic year, with the exception of:

- Ecological Methodology (10 credits) to run in Autumn term
- Environmental Geochemistry (20 credits) to run in Autumn and Spring terms

We have suspended two field-based third year option modules in 2021/2 due to the uncertainty around international travel:

- Production and Consumption Geographies Fieldtrip to Prague (EEE and HuGE)
- The Dynamics of Alpine Environments (ES and EG)

Third year students will continue to have all the same core modules, and will have a wide variety of specialist options to choose from, in spite of this slight reduction. Students who had chosen either of these modules have been contacted by the Department to choose a new option.

All other field trips are planned to go ahead but will be subject to restrictions in place closer to the time.
