Summary of Changes

We will retain coursework assessment in the summer term that we introduced last year to replace closed exams that students sat on many of our first and second year undergraduate modules.

Every year, we review our suite of optional modules in light of staff availability and changing student interest. For 2021-22, we have removed some optional undergraduate modules at the 2nd and 3rd year levels due to staff taking research leave or attracting very low enrolment numbers. None of these impact on the learning outcomes of our degree programmes.
